SURABAYA SIGHTS Surabava is Indonesia's second largest city with a population or around seven million including the surrounding rural areas. It is the main seaport and commercial centre for the eastern region of Indonesia. Our city sights tour will show us some of the city's historic buildings, the central business area, and the local Arab markets. The island of Madura with a population of four million, lies just off the coast of Surabaya. Since 2009 the island has been
